ENTRY INTO THIS DEPARTMENT, USE: FORM - S

*If an entry is received incomplete, the fair office will return the entry to the exhibitor. The entry will be accepted if completed and received in the fair office **ALONG WITH A \$25 PROCESSING FEE** within 10 days of request. If not received with the processing fee or received after the 10 days, the entry will not be accepted.* All entries must be received in the Fair Office no later than March 13, 2009. SHOWMANSHIP: Thursday, April 16, 2009, following Rabbit showmanship.

SMALL STOCK AUCTION: Fri., April 17, 7:00pm.

AWARDS: Best of Show and Best Reserve of Show.

CAVY EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

Youth Cavy show may be sanctioned and if so, will be judged according to the standards of a sanctioned show. There will be an additional class for cavies not entered in the sanctioned show. Exhibitor must indicate they wish to sell a qualifying animal by placing a "Y" in the sell column of the entry form at time of entry.

I. 4-H, FFA and Open Youth eligible to enter.

2. Diseased or unsightly cavies will not be admitted and must be removed from the fairgrounds.
3. All animals must be eartagged prior to arrival at fair.
4. No breeding of animals will be allowed on the fairgrounds at any time.
5. **Water bottles must be furnished by the exhibitor. Please feed and water before leaving when you bring in your animals. Feed will be provided by the fair. Feeding will be done by the Superintendent and assistants during fair.**
6. Maricopa County Dress Code required. Refer to *Livestock Rules - #25*
7. Removal of show animals, prior to the end of fair is prohibited. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
