3. If participant wins the showmanship division in more than one department - individual must declare which department they will represent.
4. Regarding #3 - Participant must notify the superintendent, of the department, that he/she will not be representing. Second place winner will be substituted.
5. Winners from each department will **not** show the animal from the department they represent.
6. Animal may be substituted only at discretion of the Round Robin superintendent.
7. Contestants will take a verbal test.
8. Contestants are responsible for finding animals for contest.
