PET EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. This department is open to youth, 5yrs - 18yrs.
2. Qualifying animals should be primarily kept as pets and
cannot be exhibited in any other department.
3. Tortoise and Hare Race participants ok.
4. Do not enter animals raised for meat or fur.
5. Animals *protected* by the Game and Fish Department
will not be accepted. (gila monsters, horny toads, etc.)
6. Animals that are *illegal* in Arizona *will not be accepted.*
(alligators, hedge hogs, piranhas, walking catfish, etc.)
7. Animals must be housed in suitable containers - *escape
proof!*
8. Exhibitor is responsible for maintaining food and water.

9. Keep pet areas clean and presentable. Failure to do so
could result in exclusion from participating in this
department next county fair.
